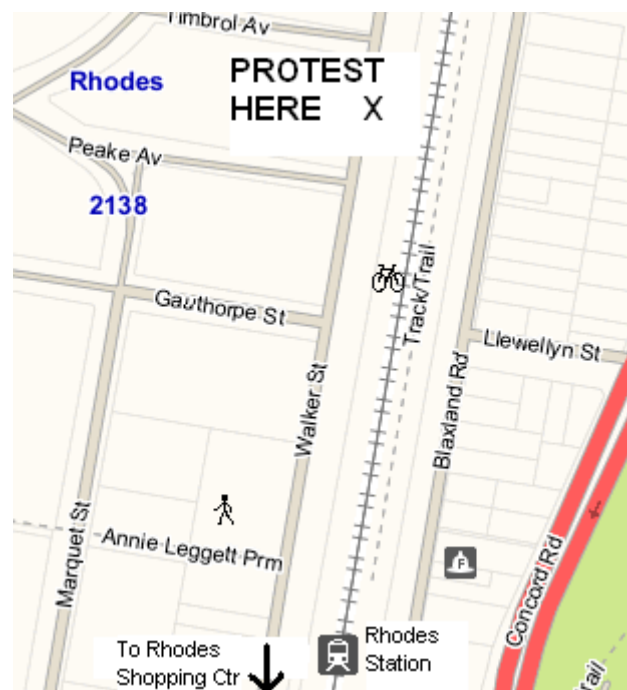
have since learned they have been replaced by backpackers. Thiess must be held accountable for their deplorable behaviour.
