# **UNSAFE POWERPACK BTL6404 TWIN HALOGEN WORKLIGHT**

Energy Safe Victoria (ESV) is concerned that some BTL6404 work lights recently sold by Bunnings stores may be unsafe.

## **PROBLEM**

There is a possibility that the work light is wired with reverse polarity which could cause an electric shock to the user and possible loss of life.

## **ACTION**

Customers who purchased a Powerpack BTL6404 Twin Halogen Work Light between November 2004 and May 2005, should telephone Manguiloi customer information line (-3) 9511 6082 between 9 am & 5 pm on Monday to Friday, to arrange for checking of the light.

**This warning notice only applies to the Powerpack BTL6404 Twin Halogen Work Light as pictured.**

**The model number BTL6404 is written on the nameplate located at the rear of the lamps.**

**This warning notice does not apply to models BTL6303, BTL6103, or BTL6302.**
